Subject: Large Animal Clinic Rotations

Soon you will be joining us to begin your senior year clerkships rotations. Hopefully, this letter will provide you with some information about the Large Animal Clinic which will be of use to you during that time.

I am the Supervisor for the Large Animal Clinic. This includes both In-House Medicine and Surgery, and Production Management Medicine, which includes Food Animal and Equine Field Services. My office is located off of Standing Surgery which is within the main Large Animal Clinic. I can be reached by phone, email, or be paged should you need to contact me.

Orientation for all services is the first Monday of each block beginning at 8:00am. It is useful for you to read the Student Orientation Manual before you come to orientation. Each section has its own expectations for its students and by reading the manual you have some idea of what is expected of you. You will receive orientation information from both technicians and clinicians.

Emergency and ICU schedules are assigned before the block. You will receive via email or at the beginning of orientation. Changes can be made if necessary provided someone within the rotation is willing to change. All changes should be noted on all schedules as well as forwarded to Communications.
